What is Kodiak X ???

- BSA's highest level of leadership training for youth

This is a coed course for all Crew Members & Troop Youth Leaders who have previously completed a Kodiak Leadership Development course!
Kodiak X is a required element for the new National Youth Leadership Society.

Cost for two days = \$45.00 (includes all Kodiak X course materials, food, and lodging). Course begins at the Fiesta Island San Diego Youth Aquatic Center on Fri Dec 18 at 7:00 PM and ends on Sat Dec 19 at 9:00 PM.

Please wear your crew uniform and arrive on time, as the course begins immediately. Bring a sleeping bag, water bottle, camera, clothes for an overnight event, jacket, towel, and personal hygiene items. You will be sleeping in bunk beds. DON'T FORGET to bring your Kodiak Bear Claws and your Kodiak Leadership bag with bag tag, pen, and notepad. Cell phones and other electronics should be left at home.
